



# AGROVISION COMMITMENT TO WATER STEWARDSHIP

**SIGNED AND DISCLOSED VIRTUALLY ON OCTOBER 30, 2020**

Agrovisión recognizes that in the long term the company's success is based on effective water stewardship in its agricultural production catchments. We believe that effective water stewardship will require that provisions be established, firstly so that water satisfies the human right to water, then to ensure that ecosystems can function and, finally, to ensure that water is used efficiently for agricultural and industrial use.

Agrovisión believes that governments should take the lead in establishing effective general policies in water in which Agrovisión and other water users can operate. Agrovisión wishes to support this process. Agrovisión is committed to developing its business in a way that facilitates effective water stewardship in the regions in which it operates and is committed to focusing on measures that are cost-effective and relevant within the catchment.

Water is an important natural resource for Agrovisión. Agriculture is one of the main users of water in the world. Agrovisión is creating a history of leadership in water stewardship through continuous improvement in the efficient use of water in its operations and innovative programs of the highest quality worldwide, as in the case of AWS (acronym for Alliance for Water Stewardship). We advocate for global and catchment-level collaborative action in water stewardship. We formally declare and reconfirm our support for the human right to water.

The "Agrovisión Commitment to Water Stewardship" has been prepared to guide and align our efforts. Specifically, Agrovisión undertakes the following:

1. Work to achieve water efficiency throughout our operations and ensure that our operations will not compromise the human right to water in local communities.
2. In our operation in Olmos, we will implement and communicate the progress of our "Water Stewardship" program to achieve improvements in the results sought by and with AWS (good water governance, sustainable water balance, good water quality, important water related areas, and water sanitation and hygiene for all).
3. The implementation of the AWS Standard in our operations in Olmos will be aligned with and in support of the existing sustainability plans of the catchment.



4. The stakeholders of our operations in Olmos will be involved in an open and transparent manner.
5. We will allocate resources to implement the AWS Standard in our operations in Olmos.
6. We will on a regular basis publicly report the progress of compliance with this commitment.
